

#### Feedback Process





The institute follows a well-planed and formal feedback system implemented at different levels. To capacitate this process of relentless enhancement, the institution adopts a feedback system that takes suggestions of the Students, Teachers and alumni on various parameters. This ultimately helps to fine-tune the teaching-learning process and the curriculum. Apart from this, the college makes an attempt to take feedbacks from teachers and alumni.

# Feedback collection process from the students of the college

Every year feedback on curriculum and other parameters is collected from the students as they have an overall idea of the curriculum. The feedback from students regarding the quality of teaching is collected in mid of the semester from under graduate students in college. The students are asked to respond to the questions that examine the effectiveness of the teaching-learning process. Furthermore, the students also give their opinion on the feedback of the institution as well as on the curriculum prescribed for them. The committee analyses the data.

### Feedback collection process from alumni of the college

The college has registered Alumni Association. The college has an alumni feedback on curriculum, infrastructure. Alumni visit the college, feedback is taken from them. The suggestions and feedbacks are received from Alumni for upgradation of various facilities and services. Data analysis and reporting are performed by feedback committee. The provided feedback data and report is presented to the head of the institution for necessary implementation.

#### Analysis of Feedback:-

- 1. Feedback collected from the Students: During the academic year 2019-20, the number of students enrolled is 287 and the feedback collected from 75 students. The feedback covers curricular aspects, infra-structure, course options, library, teaching-learning resources, Teacher-student relations, teaching methodology, academic atmosphere etc. The formal feedback contains 13 multiple choice questions and the students give their feedback selecting the options (excellent/good/ inadequate) given in the multiple choice questions. 70 % students select 'excellent' option, 20% select 'good' option and 10% students give their suggestions to use mother tongue while teaching English, Hindi subjects and difficulties to understand figures in Economics. Demand of the students to purchase books of the newly introduced syllabus (B.A.F.Y.). It is find that most of the students are satisfied by the teaching-learning methods used by the teachers.
- 2. Feedback collected from the Alumni: During the academic year 2019-20, the feedback collected from 20 Alumni. The feedback covers depth of the course contain. applicability/relevance real life situations, learning value, overall rating and suggestions. The formal feedback contains 04 multiple choice questions and the Alumni their feedback and give selecting the options (Very good/good/ satisfactory/unsatisfactory) given in the multiple choice questions. 70 % alumni select 'Very good' and 'good' options and some alumni give their suggestions to curriculum should be based on employability.
- 3. Feedback collected from the Teachers: During the academic year 2019-20, the feedback collected from 14 teachers. Out of 14 teachers, three teachers are nominated as members of board of Studies (University). The feedback covers need based curriculum, Course out-come, availability of teaching-learning resources, theory and application of the course, freedom of modification/ suggestion regarding the course, freedom of using teaching methods, slow/advance learners and suggestions. The formal feedback contains 10 multiple choice questions and the teachers give their feedback selecting the options (strongly agree/agree/ neutral/ disagree/strongly disagree) given in the multiple choice questions. 70 % teachers select strongly agree option, 20% select agree option and 10% teachers select neutral option and through suggestions, the teachers suggest to introduce need based curriculum, curriculum flexibility etc.

### Recommendations of Feedback Committee:

The action is taken based on the feedback collected from the students, alumni and the teachers. The committee recommended following issues for necessary action.

- 1. to use mother tongue while teaching subjects like English and Hindi for slow learners
- 2. to reaper difficult topics of Economics to the slow learners.
- 3. To purchase text and reference books of new syllabus.

## Action Taken by the Authority:

All the recommendations given by the Feedback Committee are considered by the authority and issued order to implement the recommendations.
